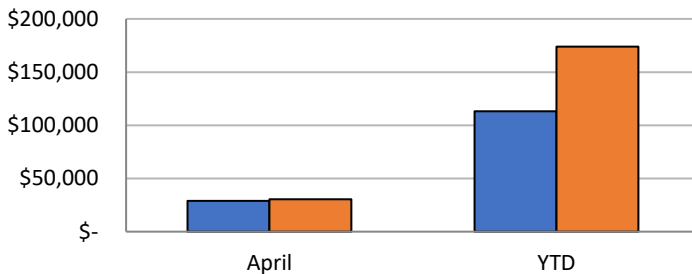

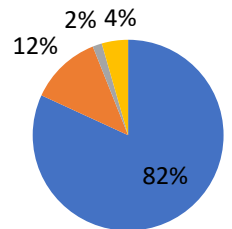

Approved Council Meeting Minutes, May 17, 2026:

Members present: Cher, Marti, Brent, Jimmy, Connie, Betsy, Ricky, Kim, Michael, Pastor Keith, Taylor, Eric, Patricia and Debbie.

I. Cher called the meeting to order at 7:04pm.

II. Devotion - Taylor Davis read a devotion on Psalm 26:3 and God's steadfast love.

III. Prayer Concerns – The Nead Family, Happy Birthday to Helen Dasher, Mike Nichols, Greg Long's family with the death of his Mother Joyce Surret, and Cher (back surgery tomorrow).

IV. Pastor's Report – Pastor reported we have 3 confirmands - Nate Rogers (due to a scheduling conflict) Confirmed on 5/17 at the early service. Jack Shealy and Shayla Bedenbaugh will be Confirmed on Pentecost, May 24. We are welcoming new members during worship on 5-17-2026: Hazel Short, Elizabeth Short, and Dee Bedenbaugh. Synod Assembly: Jerry Price and Patricia Tiffner will be lay representatives for Wittenberg at Synod Assembly at the Brookland Baptist Banquet and Conference Center, West Columbia, June 11-13. The theme this year is "Created to Create" inspired by Ephesians 2:10. We will be voting on a new bishop. Please keep us and all at the assembly in your prayers. Debbie motioned to accept Pastor's report and Michael seconded.

V. Financial Secretary's Report – Connie emailed report earlier in the week. Another Thrivent Choice donation was put into the General Fund. Patricia motioned to accept Connie's report and Ricky seconded.

VI. Treasurer's Report – Brent reported we have a reduced deficit for operations this month. We received the reimbursement from the Preschool for the painting. Two Vision 20+20 CDs matured and they have both been updated and renewed. Regular offerings are about the same from last year. Endowment Fund had a good month. Ended April at \$213,079. Unrealized gain \$12,000 for the month. Michael motioned to accept the Treasurer's report and Jimmy seconded.

VII. President's Report – Cher reported we are celebrating Pastor Keith's 4-year work anniversary! Thank you for all that you do! First Sunday Lunch June will be hosted by the Christian Education Committee. First Sunday Lunch in July has been cancelled since it falls on July 4th weekend. We are looking for a volunteer to be in charge of changing the outside church sign. Connie has been very dedicated in changing the Church Sign outside but it is time to hand this task over. Patricia volunteered to take this task. Marti motioned to accept the President's report and Kim seconded.

Christian Education: Betsy Dority reported we have Confirmation Sunday next Sunday, 5/24. Graduation Sunday is 6/7. We have 7 High School Graduates including Jack Bouknight, Demarion Brown, Wyatt Hendrix, Smith Kirby, Cade Long, Zane Price and Susie Reed. We will also be recognizing Brett Spradley who is graduating from Charleston School of Law. We are hoping to recognize Wyatt and Jack on 5/31 during worship as Wyatt will have reported to boot camp and Jack to Boys State as a counselor. We are also planning VBS which is 6/7-6/10. We are excited to announce that Robert Epting will be leading the adult class this year in the conference room!

Endowment: Eric Dickey reported they approved 6 applicants for Endowment Grants and had representation for each here for Endowment Sunday. Everything went well. Debbie motioned to accept Eric's report and Michael seconded.

Evangelism & Christian Care: Marti Burns reported they had 12 people using the tent at The SC Poultry Festival. They have been sending cards out and took dinner to Mike and Virginia. Brent took meals out for 1st Sunday Lunch. Patricia motioned to accept Marti's report and Michael seconded.

Mutual Ministry: Cher Davis – no report

Parish Life: Toshia Banks – no report

Pre-School: Debbie Black reported they met tonight. Graduation program is 5/21 at 6:30 in the sanctuary. She discussed the needs for the Preschool expansion building. They have a plan from 2018 for a 6,000 staff building including 5 classrooms drawn by Craig Otto. DSS requires 35 staff per child. There is a need for baby care in our community but this has not been addressed for this age group yet. Steven and Jimmy to get an analysis for cost and help with the financial side. Had discussion on weighing options for different types of buildings and also what do we envision for our Preschool Program. Debbie will get together an exploratory committee to start meeting about a potential new space. DSS has approved the use of the basement for afterschool activity. Discussion was had for use of this space. Debbie will find out what the intentions are for using the basement. Eric made a motion to table this discussion to a side committee. All in favor.

Property: Cher Davis (Council Liaison) reported Gutter Guard installations have been completed. Guards could not be placed on the Food Pantry building so they were used on the garage and a portion of the house. They accepted a quote for \$682 to complete the gutter guards on the parsonage. A portion of the Cemetery fence got damaged along N. Lee St. They are working on quotes to repair. The toilets in Ladies Lounge have been pulled and resealed to the floor. All repairs made by Ervin and Todd at no cost to the church. There is water damage above the sink in the basement. They scheduled our annual termite inspection for 7/7. The police using our church space during the SC Poultry Festival went well and they were very appreciative. Patricia motioned to accept Cher's report and Jimmy seconded. All in favor.

Social Ministry: Kim Hendrix reported the Soup Kitchen served 140 families in April. They would like to recognize the Pastor and his family, Jennifer Spradley, Elwanda Lorick, Chrissie Kirby, and Catherine and Mary Rae Oxner for their dedicated service. Additionally, the Food Pantry served 140 families last month. They also prepared 150 bag lunches, thanks to the hard work of Wendy Epting, Harriet Household, Ruth and Callie Brigham, and Kayce Shealy and her family. Meat was donated from Christin Ministry Center and Walmart. B-L Post Office also donated canned goods from a food drive. Last month, Donice began restocking the pantry using online ordering and delivery through Walmart. We offer a big thank you to her for taking on this new initiative. I have asked her to let us know if she needs any assistance with receiving deliveries or restocking the shelves. Michael motioned to accept Kim's report and Jimmy seconded. All in favor.

Stewardship & Finance: Jimmy St. Jean reported they did not meet tonight. No major changes. Eric motioned to accept Jimmy's report and Patricia seconded. All approved.

Strategic Planning: Cher Davis – no report

Worship & Music: Patricia Tiffner – Confirmation and Pentecost are next Sunday. Holy Trinity Sunday the following Sunday. The Cross is coming down tomorrow. Marti motioned to accept Patricia's report and Eric seconded. All approved.
