Meeting called to order at 7:05 pm.

Devotion by Ricky F. Talked about the significance of "The Manger".

Prayers & concerns: Mary Cook was just released from the hospital; Freida Banks is coming home on Tuesday; sent a sympathy card to Robert Epting on the passing of his dad; Michael Kramer still dealing with some health issues.

Pastor's report: attendance for November 2024 & 2025 is the same at 110 for in person and digital viewing, the Advent services are well attended this year, Pastor will be on vacation from 12-29 thru 1-10-2026.

Motion to approve report by Debbie Black, seconded by Ricky Frick.

Financial Secretary's report: Total donations for November was \$60,973.48, Vision 20/20 YTD donation is \$6,845.20. Motion to approve report by Betsy, seconded by Mike.

Treasurer's report: South State checking balance on 11-30-25 is \$74,856.27, Food Pantry Surplus is \$18,567.15, Soup Kitchen Surplus is \$8,204.25, Hare Reserve is \$28,475.00, Actual Checking balance is \$103,331.27. Motion to accept report by Betsy McEwen, seconded by Ricky Frick.

President's report: January's Sunday lunch will be on 1-11-2026; it will be a Potluck lunch; the "Fill the Fridge" was a large success with community involvement. Motion to approve report by Ricky Frick, seconded by Robin Taylor.

AV/T: no report.

Cemetery: no report.

Christian Education: We are in the process of getting ready for the Christmas Eve 5:30 service; we have had 20 children in the last 2 weeks who will be participating in acting out the gospel for Christmas Eve; the children will also be playing the bells and singing.

Endowment: no report.

Evangelism & Christian Care: no report.

Mutual Ministry: no report.

Pre-school: no report.

Parish Life: no report.

Property: In November the motor was replaced on the Parsonage's unit. We also have 2 estimates for some painting church's buildings; the company selected is "No Worries Painting & Pressure Washing". Motion to approve estimate by Betsy McEwen, seconded by Patricia Tiffner; the total cost is \$20,815.20; the Church is responsible for \$13,175.20 and the Preschool is responsible for \$7,640.00; Debbie Black will present this to their council for their approval.

Social Ministry: The food pantry served 662 families in November, included those who received turkeys and holiday meal boxes during the November 22 "Fill the Fridge". Hitachi donated \$13,000.00 toward this event. The soup kitchen did not serve in November due to Thanksgiving; they donated to the food pantry instead. They will resume meal service in December. The Food Pantry Advent calendar was placed in the narthex. A report on the food donations for November will be included in the December report.

Stewardship & Finance: no report.

Worship & Music: Advent services are doing well; the Christmas Eve services are being prepared; the last Sunday of the year will be a regular Sunday with breakfast, Sunday school and early service, the 11am service will be lessons and carols. The next week, 1st Sunday Pastor Schafer will preside both services. Poinsettias will be delivered on December 20th; no time has been set yet for the removal of the Christmas tree. We will meet again in January 2026.

Youth: will provide breakfast on Sunday morning after Christmas.

Motion to approve all committees reports by Debbie Black, seconded by Kim Hendrix.

The Executive Committee Members are President Cher Davis, VP Michael Guerette and Secretary Betsy Dority, Motion to approve voted members by Debbie Black, seconded by Ricky Frick.

Meeting was adjourned at 8:11pm with the Lord's Prayer.
